### Coach's expectations include but are not limited to the following

### **Professional Obligations and Responsibilities**

- Holding current Professional Skating membership and Liability insurance for coaching as prescribed in Membership Guide; providing documentation as requested or required
- Educating skating parents and students appropriately, particularly in regard to their behavior, etiquette and responsibilities
- Following ISI testing protocol as determined by the FMC Central Mass Skating Club and competition protocol as determined by ISI or ISI District 1
- Ensuring skaters are Club members, have paid any fees, signed forms, etc. before utilizing sessions and are abiding by rules and club standards at all times
- Changing skates and conducting business in common or specified areas of the facility only.

#### Professional and Ethical Practices, Dress & Behavior

- Disclosing professional practices and fees up front
- Valuing educational events and resources available to fulfill professional obligations
- Putting needs of Students before needs of Professionals
- Displaying good sportsmanship, honoring the game, valuing loyalty &
- Refraining from bashing others, gossiping, being overly negative or venting inappropriately
- Making the rink a "safe zone"; Engaging in positive and supportive behaviors of all skaters; Asking others to do the same; Alerting authorities in the event that inappropriate behavior or conduct is being displayed

### Respect for FMC, the facility, programs, staff, etc.

- Compliance with all rules, policies, procedures, terms and conditions of the facility, programs, etc.
- Wearing only FMC branded or non branded apparel on Club Ice sessions
- Allowing skaters to bloom where planted and promote trust amongst skaters and coaches; solicitation and/or skater migration, of the coach or affiliated parties, will result in immediate revocation of club membership at the offender's expense
- Being supportive of FMC programs, encouraging skaters to participate and/or being available to teach
- Being considerate and respectful of rink staff and property

Coaches interested in teaching on FMC Skating Club Ice Practice sessions must a Professional Member of the appropriate FMC Skating Club division. Expectations of Professional members are outlined in this brochure and more detailed information found in the Professional Membership Guide. To apply, Coaches must:

- Be of the appropriate age to legally enter into a contract
- Apply for membership in advance and if accepted, pay any fees and sign appropriate documents prior to teaching; coaches may not be allowed to teach until this requirement is met; please allow 2-3 weeks for processing
- For Annual membership, be an ISI Professional Member in good standing; For seasonal membership, be an ISI or PSA member in good standing
- Have a current Liability Insurance Policy with Facility Management Corporation and the Commonwealth of Massachusetts as additional insured and provide a copy of the Liability Insurance Certificate prior to teaching
- Hold ISI judge's certification to the level of any ISI students and fulfilled CER requirements if teaching US students
- Attend required number of Club Coach's meetings, seminars and/or have acquired appropriate resources (manuals, handbooks, etc.)
- Support Club events both with student participation as well as volunteer hours as
- Own Membership fees and not pass them along to students
- Be free and clear of any fees due to FMC Ice Sports or their affiliates; Membership cannot be approved or membership reinstated until debts are paid
