The scholarships are awarded to ice hockey, figure skating and recreational skating participants in June of each year. **All applicants must be New England residents and skate at FMC arenas.**

Scholarship winners are selected by a review committee and are based upon the applicant's academic performance, involvement in extracurricular and community activities, as well as their accomplishments and leadership on the ice.
